FOLLOW THESE TIPS TO ENSURE MAXIMUM APPLICATION ACCURACY AND COMPLIANCE WITH LABEL USE DIRECTIONS.

1 READ DIRECTIONS

Always read and follow label directions. It's an important, sophisticated document that covers vital information regarding proper use of products.

2 PLAN

The most comprehensive weed resistance programs use herbicides with multiple, effective sites of action and employ cultural and mechanical practices together with a monitoring program on the constant lookout for the first signs of weed resistance development.

3 EVALUATE

Consider environmental factors before spraying. Check for inversion conditions and don't spray if they exist. Calm air may indicate a temperature inversion which can keep spray droplets suspended longer with potential to move downwind.

4 SELECT

Nozzle selection is crucial. Spray droplet calibration ensures that the spectrum maximizes efficacy while minimizing drift.

5 CALIBRATE

Adjust sprayers at the start of the application season and maintain routine inspections to check for nozzle wear and tear.

6 BE AWARE

Consult sensitive crop registries and contact sensitive crop growers about planned applications.

7 CLEAN EQUIPMENT

Regular equipment cleaning can add life to your program and minimize unnecessary replacement costs.

8 MAXIMIZE

Select proper spray adjuvants to maximize product performance.

9 CONFIGURE

Set your equipment to achieve on target application for effective weed control.

10 TRACK

Keep complete and accurate records to track your application decisions including products and equipment used.

11 HANDLE, STORE & DISPOSE

Follow all label directions on handling, storing and disposing of products.
